<u>Muhammad- 'Alí Sháh</u>	1907 - 1909 CE		1909 'Abdu'l-Bahá released from imprisonment
<u>Ahmád Sháh</u>	1909 - 1925 CE		1921 Ascension of 'Abdu'l-Bahá

- 1501 - 1722 : Safavid Dynasty (Shi'a; capital Isfahan)
 - Afghan invasion (Sunní)
 - 1736 - 47 : Nadir Sháh (belief ? - tribe of Afshar - Sunni)
 - 1750 - 79 Karím Khán Zand (Shi'a; capital Shiraz)
- Period of tribal conflict (esp. Afshárs, Zands and Qájárs)
- 1776 Áqá Muhammad Khán-i-Qájár begins to gain supremacy and established by 1779
 - 1796 he is crowned as 1st Qájár king. Shi'a; capital Teheran. Assassinated 1797.

- 1909 - 21 : Ahmad Sháh - the last Qájár
- 1921 : Rezá Sháh coup - 1st Pahlaví Sháh
